



SI Supplemental Instruction

The Student Success Center seeks qualified sophomores and juniors to become Supplemental Instruction (SI) Leaders for 2008-2009. SI sessions are facilitated by SI Leaders, students who have previously and successfully completed the course. Study sessions are held several times each week and are designed to help students review and understand course content.

SI positions are anticipated for

- Math 119
- Chemistry 120
- Biology 101
- Math 130
- Chemistry 130
- Biology 102

SI Leaders will be paid \$9 per hour for 8-10 hours per week for fall semester. Performance will determine continued employment for spring semester.

SI Leader Qualifications

1. Junior or senior standing is preferred.
2. An overall GPA of 3.0 or above is preferred.
3. A grade of 3.0 or above in the selected course is required; prior enrollment with the professor who is to teach the selected course is preferred, but not required.
4. Content-competency (to be determined by the selected course professor) is required.
5. Good interpersonal and communication skills (to be determined by the SI supervisor) are required.
6. Comfort and skill in public speaking are required.
7. Availability during some weekday evenings to conduct SI sessions.

Primary Activities

1. Attend class meetings of the selected sections of the course, take notes, do homework and read assigned materials, including text(s) and supplemental readings.
2. Conduct at least two or three 50-minute study sessions per week throughout the term using strategies learned through the SI leader training workshop.
3. Regularly meet with the SI supervisor to discuss observations of the SI sessions, to discuss the creation and use of SI session handouts, and to discuss the planning of SI sessions and use of a wide variety of learning strategies.
 - a. Notify supervisor about problems or potential problems.
4. Hold office hours in the Student Success Center to be available for individualized assistance.
5. Assist SI supervisor in training other SI leaders.
