Students presenting their work at conferences may apply for funds to partially defray the costs of registration and travel. The amounts awarded are: •\$300 for regional conferences (TN and any contiguous state) •\$500 for national conferences •\$800 for international conferences


Ready to present your undergraduate research? Or maybe you'll be ready by Spring 2018. We have some upcoming deadlines that are important for you to know!

Posters at the Capitol - Deadline November 7 (posters only)
